QSSSA

- Question: Ask a question based upon a key concept
- Signal: Provide a way to indicate readiness
- Stem: Provide a sentence starter for answering the question
- Share: Explain how students will respond to the question using the stem
- Assess: Randomly select students or ask everyone to write their response



QSSSA

Question: What did you notice?

Signal: Sit down 👃

Stem: I noticed.....

Share: 👤

Assess: Random Call or Write Something






