



**ETERNAL:** No beginning or end

TRANSCENDENT: Above all

**PREEMINENT:** Before all

**POWERFUL:** Having control or influence

**SOVEREIGN:** Supreme ruler with supreme

authority

**ORDERED:** Arranges in a particular way

**WISE:** Having/showing good judgement

**GOOD:** Benefits someone or something


**RELATIONAL:** Desires relationship (aka Loving)

WORTHY of GLORY: High renown or honor won

by notable achievements

Psalm 100:3: "Know that the Lord, He is God. It is He who made us, and we are His..."




#### **Gospel Identity: Fall**



Genesis 3:8 "...and the man and his wife hid themselves..."




#### Gospel Identity: Redemption

#### Gospel Identity: Restoration



2 Cor. 5:20: "Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God."
